**P**opcorn, cotton candy, hot dogs, enough candy to fill up my office and lots of fun games for everyone! It's Harvest Festival time again.

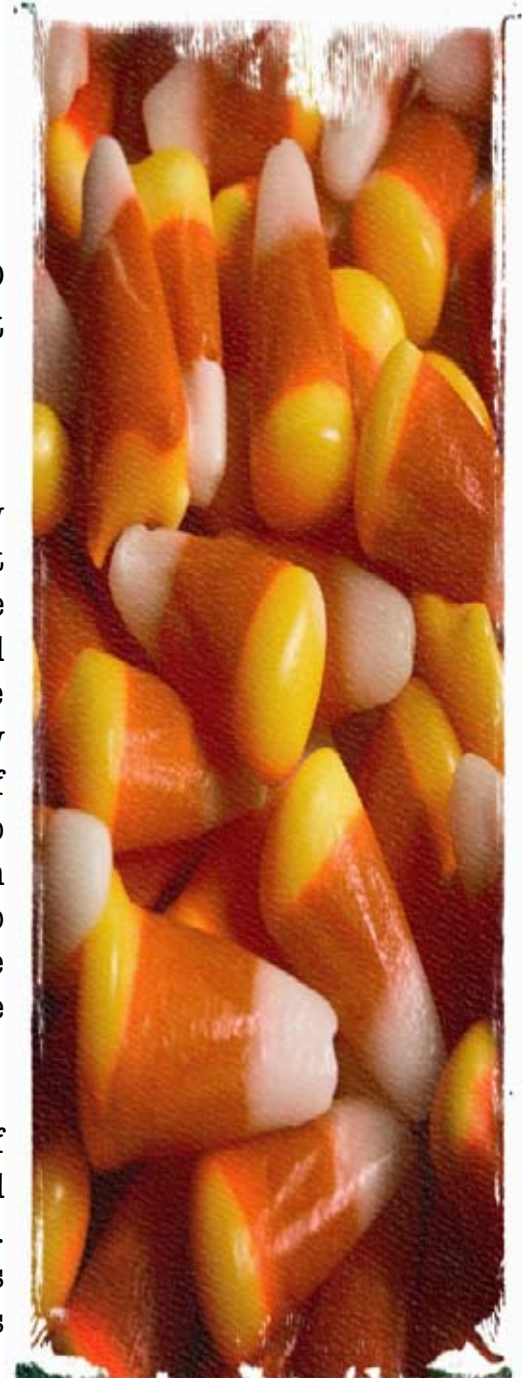

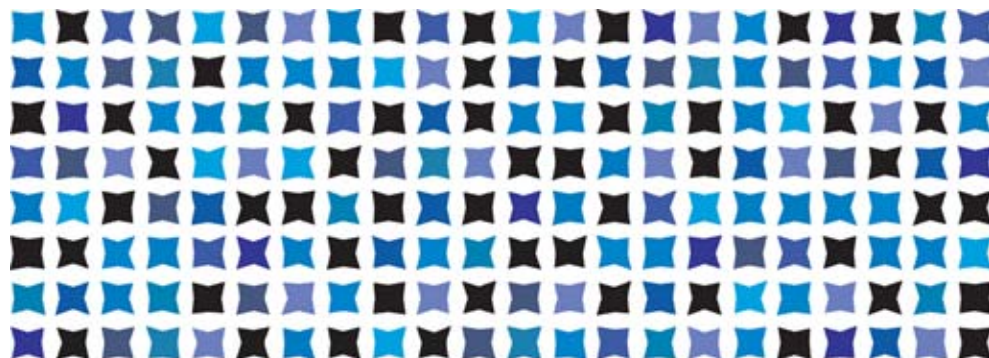
Why do we do the Harvest Festival? Because we want to reach out to our community with the love of

# BREAKOUT! WHAT IS IT?

**B**reakout kicks-off September 29 at 6:30 pm! “But what is Breakout?” you ask. Breakout is part of the strategy of PCC’s children’s ministry designed to move children toward spiritual maturity through mentoring relationships, small group interaction, fellowship and worship.

## **Worship**

The night begins with our worship team leading us in worship. Our worship team is led by Laura Junkermann and selected children who show a desire for spiritual growth by completing their lessons each week, and show an ability to lead in motions to the music, and who exhibit a servant’s heart.

## **Small Group**

After worship, the children will breakout into their small groups where they will talk about their lesson, exchange prayer requests, and spend time praying for one another. Our anticipation is that their new understanding of Christ changes how they live. Every group has an adult leader with up to eight children.

## **Games**

This time is spent playing fun games where everyone can participate. The intention is to have fun and learn

important sportsmanship skills.

## **Snack/Listening**

During the snack time children will meet in their groups around a table. While eating their snack children will say the verse they memorized. This provides accountability and encouragement to all the children.

## **The Curriculum**

We want to teach children the Bible from an early age. Second Timothy 3:15 says, “Since you were a child you have known the Holy Scriptures which are able to make you wise. And that wisdom leads to salvation through faith in Christ Jesus.”

## **4 year olds though 2nd Graders**

These books are designed to take kids through the Bible in four years, focusing on the values taught in each Bible story. Four-year olds will start with Creation in Book One and 2nd graders end with Paul’s Missionary Journeys in Book Four.

## **3rd through 5th Graders**

The older kids have three books they are working through. Book 1 focuses on Knowing Christ. Children will learn and discuss topics such as salvation, forgiveness, putting Christ first, and

having a quiet time. Book 2 focuses on Growing in Christ. Each child will grow in the wisdom and understanding of who Christ is, while learning and discussing topics such as fellowship, giving and Bible memory. Book 3 focuses on Serving Christ. Children will learn and discuss topics related to how they best can serve the Body of Christ and why spending regular time in God’s word is so important.

## **Leaders**

Now even though I spent time sharing about the curriculum, the curriculum is really secondary to the primacy of our leaders. I’ve always believed that the quality of your leaders either makes or breaks your program. I am lucky enough to have extremely talented, dedicated, well-qualified and mature leaders in Breakout. I praise God for them! As they invest their lives into the children and continue to grow themselves, we see miraculous things happen in the children’s lives. It is awesome to see!

## **Pray**

Would you pray that our leaders and children would “please Him in every way: bearing fruit in every good work, growing in the knowledge of God” (Col 1:10)

# SEATTLE SNEAK PEEK

The first week of August we brought a team of 15 people to serve Venture Church (a church plant) in Marysville, WA, a suburb of Seattle. Our main goal was to serve Venture in any way that would be beneficial for them. We put on a couple “block parties,” which were free to the community. Our students made snow cones and cotton candy, set up and rolled back up giant inflatable bouncers, and helped Venture church gain respect and trust in their communities.

We also served the residents of one area by doing simple yard work and maintenance. But perhaps the most challenging area of ministry we engaged in was going door to door in the community and asking people to fill out a survey for Venture Church,

to help them understand the needs of the community better. We faced many closed doors (some literally closed in our face). But some were open. One individual who completed a survey came to Venture’s service at Pastor Troy’s house that Saturday night. A few weeks later, we found out he has ended up making a decision to trust Christ as savior!

There are too many stories to recount – but we would like to be able to share in more depth with those who want to hear. Come join us on Sunday, September 19 at 6 pm for dessert and an extended discussion of our week of ministry in one of the most spiritually empty places in the US.

## WHY WE NEED RETREATS

Especially after this summer, I can’t reiterate the importance of retreats. It gives us the chance to step out of the ebb and flow of everyday life, away from the distractions, and encounter God in a fresh way. For both our junior high and high school retreats this year, students were able to expand their view of who God is in their life and have a setting to freely worship God wholeheartedly. ## COLLEGE/ CAREER

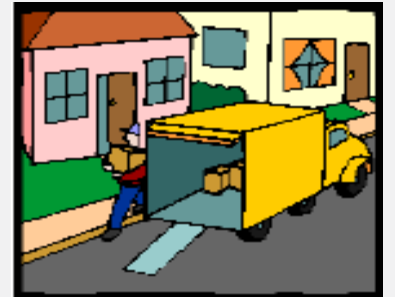
